A Guide To Recycling In Washington Township at the Convenience and Recycling Center

Residents who do not have or don't use curbside collection from their garbage hauler may take materials to the Washington Township drop-off recycling center.

Where: The Washington Twp. Public Works Facility, 22 East Front Street (Port Colden) located behind the Port Colden School

When: The Second Saturday of each month; from 9:00 am - 3:00 pm

How: *NEW THIS YEAR *Materials brought to the center have to be separated:

GLASS



MUST BE PLACED IN APPROPRIATE LOCATION

Bottles & Jars Only

NO LIGHT BULBS, CERAMICS, WINDOWS, DISHES, FLOWER VASES

Remove & discard lids, rings, and foil. Rinse clean.

METAL



MUST BE PLACED IN APPROPRIATE LOCATION

Alluminum Cans- a magnet doesn't stick

NO FOIL OR PIE PANS

Rinse clean and flatten.

Tin & Bimetal Cans-a magnet will stick to these cans

Rinse clean and flatten; remove labels.

NEWSPAPER



Must be bundled and securely tied with twine.

NO PLASTIC BAGS OR OTHER PAPER

PAPER



***MUST BE BUNDLED WITH LIKE MATERIALS**

Includes: Magazines, Junk Mail, White Office Paper, Copier Paper and Computer Paper, Telephone Books.

Note: beverage cases, cereal boxes, shoe/gift boxes may be bundled and placed with mixed paper.

No: Carbon Paper, Foil or Plastic Coated Papers.

PLASTICS



PLASTIC CAN BE CO-MINGLED WITH OTHER PLASTIC

Bottles/Containers

Drain bottles/containers completely, remove and discard rings, rinse clean and flatten (if possible).

IMPORTANT: Look for the recycling symbol and number on the bottom. This facility accepts Plastics #1-5 and #7. [#1 PETE Clear (soda), #1 PETE Brown and Green (soda, coffee), #2 HDPE Natural (milk), #2 HDPE Colored (detergent), #3 V (water bottles, salad dressing bottles), #4 LDPE (food storage containers), #5 PP (bottle caps, plastic lids), #7 Other (tupperware and other than plastic #1-5)].

NO CONTAINERS THAT CONTAINED MOTOR OIL, PESTICIDES OR HAZARDOUS CHEMICALS ARE TO BE DROPPED OFF.

CORRUGATED CARDBOARD



Cardboard with a top & bottom outside layer and an inside waffle layer. Brown paper bags also accepted.

Flatten, bundle, and tie securely with twine. Other types of cardboard such as, beverage cases, cereal boxes, shoe/gift boxes may be bundled and placed with mixed paper.

Used Clothing is now being accepted.



HOUSEHOLD BATTERIES: Rechargeable Batteries can be recycled at the Washington Township Municipal Building. A drop box is located on the top floor – Administrative Office hallway. Rechargeable batteries include Nickel Cadmium (Ni-Cd), Nickel Metal Hydride (Ni-MH), Lithium Ion (Li-ion), Nickel Zinc (Ni-Zn), and Small Sealed Lead (pb). There is also a collection barrel at the Warren County District Landfill, Monday thru Friday, 7:00 a.m. – 2:30 p.m., and Saturday 7:00 a.m. – 11:00 a.m. **Non-Rechargeable Batteries** (alkaline dry cell batteries) such as AA, AAA, C, D and 9 volt no longer contain mercury or hazardous components and therefore may be disposed of in your regular household trash.

CELL PHONES: Cell phones can be recycled at the Washington Township Municipal Building, top floor – Administrative Office hallway. We accept any size, make, model, digital or analog, with or without battery. Cell phone accessories are not accepted.

VEGETATIVE WASTE SCHEDULE for 2012

BRUSH: TIED IN MANAGEABLE BUNDLES (1 tag per pickup) will be picked up during the months of April, May, September and October curbside by 6:00 a.m. on non-holiday Fridays according to the following schedule:

South of Route 57 - First and third full weeks of the month:

April 05 (Thursday)	May 04	September 07	October 05
April 20	May 18	September 21	October 19

North of Route 57 - Second and fourth full weeks of the month:

April 13	May 11	September 14	October 12
April 27	May 25	September 28	October 26

Brush will also be picked up on June 29th and must be Curbside (Monday) at 6:00 a.m. **Both North & South of Route 57.**

LEAVES: (in clear 30 gallon bags only with stickers attached) and other related garden-type debris, **(NO GRASS AND NO STICKS)** will be picked up during the months of April, May, September and October on the same schedule as the brush pickup (see above) by 6:00 a.m. on non-holiday **Fridays.**

Leaves **ONLY (NO GRASS AND NO STICKS)** and other related garden-type debris will also be picked up during the Fall (**Township wide both North side and South side**) November-December by 6:00 a.m. **on Thursdays:**

November 08	November 21	December 06	

***(Wednesday)**

GRASS CLIPPINGS: Will **not** be picked up curbside. May be taken to the Port Colden Convenience Center along with garden variety waste and leaves, and placed in the separately marked holding areas by obtaining a Convenience Center Pass (see fees).

CHRISTMAS TREES: (no fee required) will be picked up curbside. Must be placed at curbside by 6:00 a.m. Thursdays, January - February; or can be dropped off at the Convenience Center.

FEES: Convenience Center Annual Fee: \$ 30.00 Curbside Collection Annual Fee: \$ 50.00

Fees must be paid prior to services being provided. Annual fees shall cover the period from January 1, 2012 to December 31, 2012.

Convenience Center Pass and Curbside tags/stickers- Residents may pay fees for a Convenience Center Pass and Curbside tags/stickers at the Washington Township Finance Department, located at the Administration Building, 211 Route 31 North (908) 689-7203 on Mondays from 11:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. or via mail.
