The Washington Township Police Department is recruiting for the position of full-time Police Officer. We are seeking energetic, enthusiastic, and hard working individuals for our police department. The Washington Township Police Department is a community oriented agency whose members take pride in their proactive community relations and a steadfast response to crime, disorder and quality of life issues for all that we serve. This approach recognizes our community's high expectations for professional police services and has sustained a positive relationship with our community for many years. We currently employ 26 full-time police officers, 5 School Resource Officers, 1 Homeland Security Officer and 2 civilian employees.

We provide proactive coverage for 3 municipalities that span over 27 square miles with approximately 17,000 residents. Our Department is comprised of a Patrol Division, Investigative Division, Narcotics, and K-9 Teams, along with other specialized assignments such as Bike Patrol, LEAD, and Warren County Tactical Response Team.

Applicants must: be between ages of 18 and 35, possess a valid NJ driver's license, and possess a current New Jersey PTC Basic Police Officer Certification or a waiver eligible New Jersey PTC Basic Special Police Officer II certification. Starting salary is \$42,600 - \$57,600 which will be based on certification and experience.
